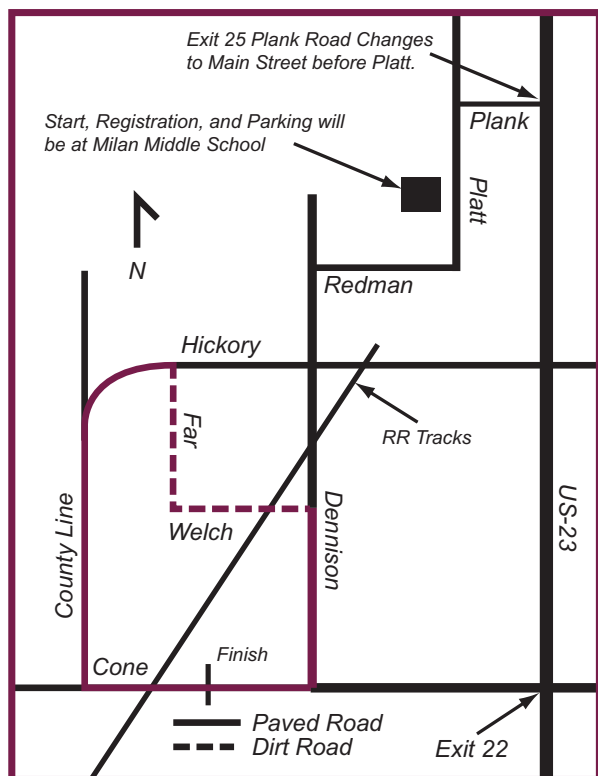

This year's event will start with a 5 mile neutral start. The race will cover a seven mile, six corner course. One corner will turn on to bumpy rough dirt roads. The course will be windy and possibly muddy. Ride your strongest wheels with wide tires!



Race will start at the middle school and riders will head down Platt, across Redman, and down Dennison to Cone. The race will start after the turn on to Cone Road. The race will finish on Cone Road.

Categories will ride the following:

A	8 Laps	100 km	\$1000 + primes
B	5 Laps	66 km	\$400 cash/prizes
C	2 Laps	33 km	\$200 cash/prizes

Prizes will be paid 10 places deep for all categories. Prize list based on fifty riders per category. Primes awarded on every lap for the A race.

Directions:

From the North: Hwy 23 S. Take exit 21 and go right on Plank. Take a left on Platt to the school lot.

From the South: Hwy 23 N. Take exit 21 and go left on Plank. Take a left on Platt to the school lot.

From the East: I-94 west to hwy 23 S. Take exit 21 and go right on Plank. Take a left on Platt to the school lot.

From the West: I-94 east to hwy 23 S. Take exit 21 and go right on Plank. Take a left on Platt to the school lot.

This year the race is a special bonus event of the Michigan Challenge Points Series. We will award 3 points to all starters and 5 to all finishers. There will be one neutral support vehicle for each race. Club support vehicles are restricted to 3 per race, and you must reserve your place by sending vehicle information (license plate number make and color of vehicle, driver name) to the address listed above.
